

The Town has hired a contractor to provide collection of vegetative debris (VEG) such as limbs, trees, stumps. The same contractor will also collect construction and demolition debris (C&D) such as furniture, wood, carpets and other home contents. All of this debris must be moved to the side of the road of collection. We cannot go on private property to collect debris of any kind. Also, we will not be removing any trees from private property. Our removal service will stop at the edge of the street right-of-way (ROW). Any tree debris that is on your side of the street ROW, must be moved to the edge of the street for collection. Do not place debris of any kind on the pavement. Place it close to pavement but not on it. Keep tree limbs and stumps to a maximum of 8 feet in length. Do not bag leaves or other vegetative debris. C&D debris may be placed in bags. Do not mix debris piles. Keep all C&D debris in a pile and keep all VEG in a pile. They go to separate areas of the landfill and our contractor will not be separating debris types. Mixed piles will not be collected.

The first pass to begin collection of both types of debris is scheduled to begin on September 24. Obviously, there is a massive amount of debris. The first pass will take a few days to collect. Another pass will be made at a later date. You are not required to get all of your debris to the road edge before the first pass. When a date for the final pass has been determined, we will announce that date in advance.
