Debris removal services are nearly complete. We began debris removal on September 24. As of October 17, we have worked for 23 days and have collected 532 loads of vegetative debris totaling 21,000 cubic yards and 534 loads of demolition debris totaling 5,744,000 pounds. We have now planned our final phase of debris collection. It is detailed below.

We said from the beginning that there would be two passes made across town for debris collection. Once the first pass is complete, we would announce a date for the second pass. The second pass for Zone 2 (which is the area outlined by the black border on the map) will begin on October 22. I completed an inspection of this entire area today and luckily very little debris remains. Once the debris contractor completes the second pass of each street in this area, any hurricane related debris placed on this street will not be collected by the contractor or the town. For example, the contractor will begin the second pass in this area on October 22 by picking up debris on Barbara Drive. Once he completes Barbara Drive, he will not be returning to Barbara Drive. It will be complete. That same process will continue for every street in that area, each street being marked off as it is completed. We hope to have Zone 2 completed by October 26. Once complete, we will not be returning to this area for hurricane related debris removal.

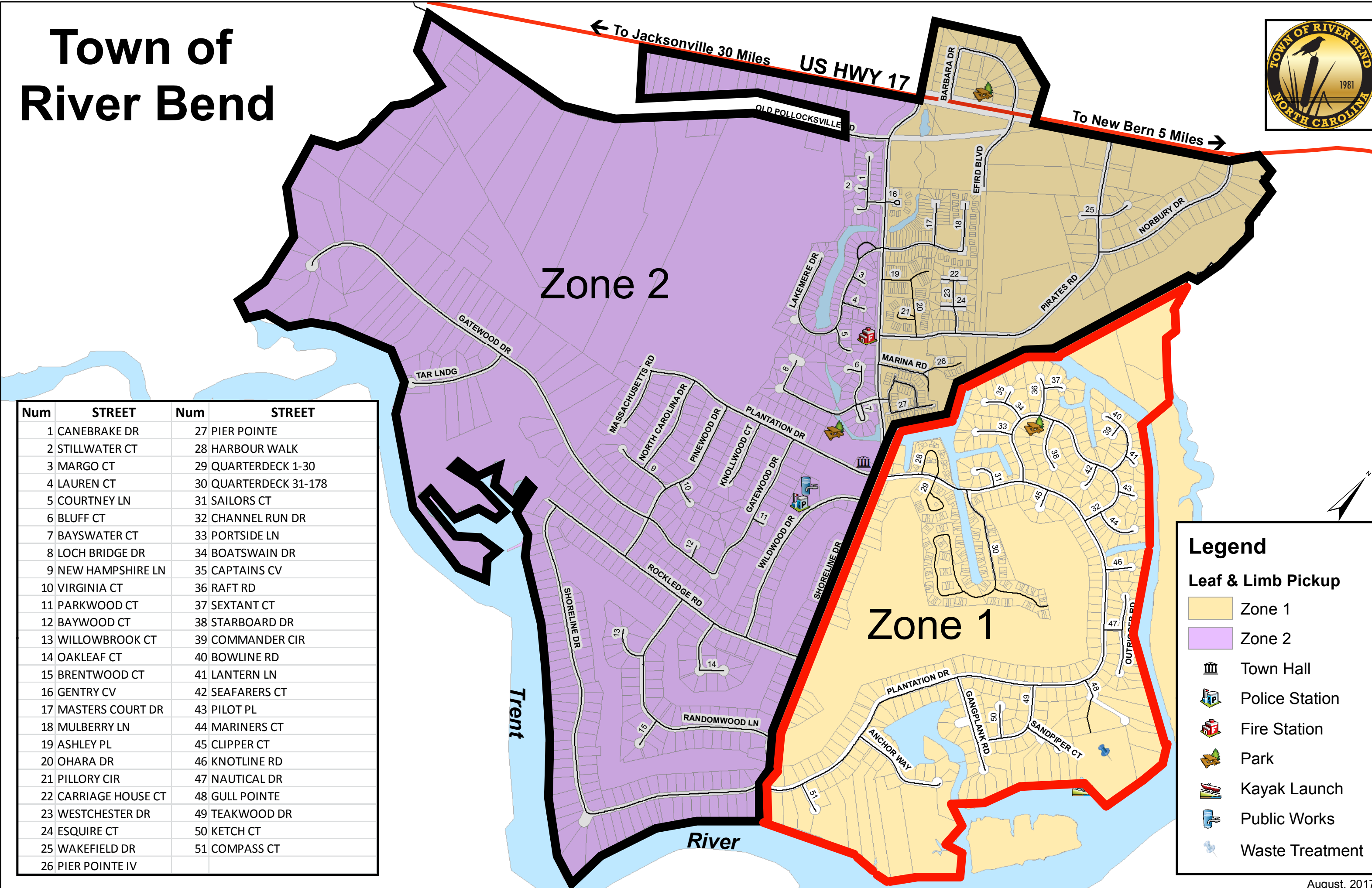
On October 29, we will begin the second pass for Zone 1 (which is the area outlined by the red border on the map) The process for this area will be the same as described for Zone 2 except the start date will be different. On October 29, the contractor will begin the second pass in Zone 1 by picking up debris on Plantation Drive. Once he completes Plantation Drive, he will not be returning to Plantation Drive. It will be complete. That same process will continue for every street in this area, each street being marked off as it is completed. We hope to have Zone 1 completed by November 2. Once complete, we will not be returning to this area for hurricane related debris removal. The first pass for Zone 1 will continue as the second pass for Zone 2 is taking place.

The second pass for each area will be the **FINAL** pass. After the second pass is complete in each area, we will not be collecting any more hurricane related debris. Any remaining debris will be the responsibility of the landowner to remove. The contractor will not be providing detailed raking and/or sweeping of each lot. I strongly encourage each landowner to rake up, sweep and tidy up any remaining small pieces of debris into a single pile in your yard and make sure it is close to the paved road. The contractor will do his best to collect it all, but he is not required to clean up every small piece of debris. That would be too time consuming. After the second pass is complete, each homeowner will be responsible for any detailed removal of any small debris that remains. For the purposes of this announcement, do not confuse the regular Zone 1 & 2 leaf collection map for the areas described herein by the black and red borders. For this announcement, Zone 2 is defined by the area with the black border and Zone 1 is defined as the area with the red border. This debris removal project was the largest debris removal project in the history of the Town of River Bend. Thank you for the cooperation and patience that was displayed during the project.

We will resume regular leaf and limb collection on November 5 except that the dates for the zones will be reversed for the November collection cycle only. Regular leaf & limb collection for Zone 2 will begin on November 5 and Zone 1 will begin on November 12. The normal rules for leaf and limb collection will be in effect for this collection.
