

I am very pleased to announce that beginning at 8 a.m. on Saturday, September 22nd, The River Bend Country Club (RBCC) will graciously open part of their facility at 94 Shoreline Drive as a temporary home for r/v's, campers and travel trailers to park and be used as temporary living quarters. Attached is a map that indicates the designated parking area. Please be thoughtful and park in an organized manner that allows movement of other vehicles in the parking area. Please park in the same fashion that you would in a camp ground or r/v park. Do not skip spaces. Park immediately next to the last vehicle already on site. This parking area is a grass area. Movement of campers, etc. in this area should be very limited so that it will not create damage to the ground and create ruts. No passenger vehicles are allowed on the grass. Passenger vehicles may park in the paved area close to the pool house. The RBCC has donated this spot for your usage during this disaster. You can show your appreciation by taking care of it while you are there. Remember, this is their front yard. A potable water source will be available on site. The town is working to secure a sewer dump location. You must register your r/v at Town Hall. Bring your license plate number with you. There is no registration fee.

In addition, the RBCC will also open their pool house for 24 hr. usage by those people who are camping out at this location. It has bathroom facilities, including showers. DO NOT go in the pool. The pool is not open for your usage. Bring your own toiletries including toilet paper.
