# RIVER BEND COMMUNITY W ATCH MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AND PRIVILEGES

# **Membership Requirements**

- Membership in Community Watch is free.
- Members must reside in the Town of River Bend and be at least eighteen years of age.
- All resident applicants must fill out a Membership Application and Liability Release.
   You will be notified within thirty days regarding the status of your approval to join the Community Watch.
- Membership may be terminated at any time for unacceptable behavior or violation of the Rules and Regulations set forth by the Police Department and Community Watch.
- Every member will receive organizational literature and a Policy and Procedure Manual detailing crime reporting, patrol and general guidelines.
- Community Watch Patrollers are not allowed to carry firearms or weapons of any kind.
- Patrollers are not to engage suspected criminals in any manner or attempt to apprehend.
- Members are not to divulge proprietary Community Watch or law enforcement information to the general public or use such information for personal gain or agenda.

# **Membership Privileges**

Each Community Watch member:

- 1. Will have one vote at the three per year general membership meetings.
- 2. May run for any officer positions.
- 3. May serve on task forces, standing and appointed committees.
- 4. May bring any business before the membership.
- 5. May have items placed on meeting agendas for consideration.
- 6. May voice comments, suggestions, questions and concerns at general meetings.

### **COMMUNITY WATCH BY-LAWS** ARTICLE I-NAME

The name of the organization shall be RIVER BEND COMMUNITY WATCH ASSOCIATION.

### ARTICLE II - OBJECT

The object of this organization shall be (a) to serve as a crime prevention program which enlists the active participation of citizens in cooperating with law enforcement to reduce crime in the community, (b) to foster the process of neighbors getting to know each other and working together in programs of mutual assistance to prevent crimes and to train residents to recognize and report suspicious activities in their neighborhoods, and (c) to operate as a non political association.

### ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

River Bend residents or property owners who are at least (18) years of age and who are interested in the object of this organization may become members by active participation in the activities of the association.

### ARTICILE IV - OFFICERS

The officers of this organization shall be President, Vice President and Secretary/Treasurer. Term of office shall be one calendar year. The officers shall be in charge of the affairs of the association between meetings of the membership.

Section 2. The duties of the officers shall be as follows:

- (a) President: shall preside at all meetings of the association, represent it as needed, and appoint committees, as decided by the association. And shall keep a list of all volunteers for patrol duty and make schedules for their patrols.
- (b) Vice President: shall assume the duties of the president, when the president is not able to perform them.
- (c) Secretary/ Treasurer: shall record minutes of the meetings, keep a roll of the members, take care of needed correspondence and collect and disburse monies as directed by the association.

### **ARTICLE V - MEETINGS**

Section 1. The association shall meet on the third Wednesday of February, June and October at 7:00PM at the River Bend Town Hall.

Section2. "Special Meetings" called by officers, must have ten (10) day's prior notice given on the Town Hall Bulletin Board.

Section 3. A majority of the votes cast by attending members shall constitute a quorum.

### **ARTICLE VI- ELECTIONS**

Section1. Elections shall be held at the first meeting of the calendar year.

Section 2. Notification will be made to the River Bend public at least 30 days prior to the Community Watch elections. Any resident interested in pursuing an officer position with Community Watch would be asked to attend the February scheduled meeting, where their name would then be put in for consideration. All Community watch members in attendance at the February meeting will then cast their votes for the candidate of their choice.

Section 3. Voting may be by voice or by ballot.

ARTICLE VII – PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

The rules contained in Robert's Rules of Order shall govern this organization in all cases in which they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with these By-Laws.

### ARTICLE VIII - AMMENDMENTS TO THE BY-LAWS

These By-laws may be amended at any regular meeting of the association, provided notice is given at least ten (10) days prior to the vote. A majority of the members in attendance is needed to pass any By-Law changes. The River Bender is the official publicity organ of the association.

Adopted at regular meeting of June 19,2012, by unanimous vote of the members that were present.
