# WRD/PW REPORT BY INTERIM PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR IAMES IONES

During the month of October, the Public Works Department performed maintenance and decking board repairs on the kayak launch. Several decking

boards were replaced along the dock. In addition, the lower railing was replaced on the entire length of the dock. This lower railing replacement will make it easier for Public Works to remove leaves from the launch. Public Works added an outside water line and spigot at the Town's new Public Works Building. This new water line gives access to water for the dog kennel and back portion of the equipment shelter. The department also helped prepare for several town events in the month of October, including National Night Out. In addition, a few damaged or broken road signs were replaced during the month.

Water Resources responded to several water service line leaks over the month. The leaks were identified, located, and repaired. Potassium permanganate treatment began in October on the town's water filters, with the hopes that all filters will be treated before the end of November. Repairs were also made to a leaking hypochlorite tank at the wastewater treatment plant. A new bar screen dumpster was brought in and plumbed up to replace the dilapidated old one. Water resources have been helping and preparing for the work that is beginning on the new Wastewater Treatment Plant. Dead-end line flushing also began at the end of the month, with hopes to alleviate brown water complaints.
