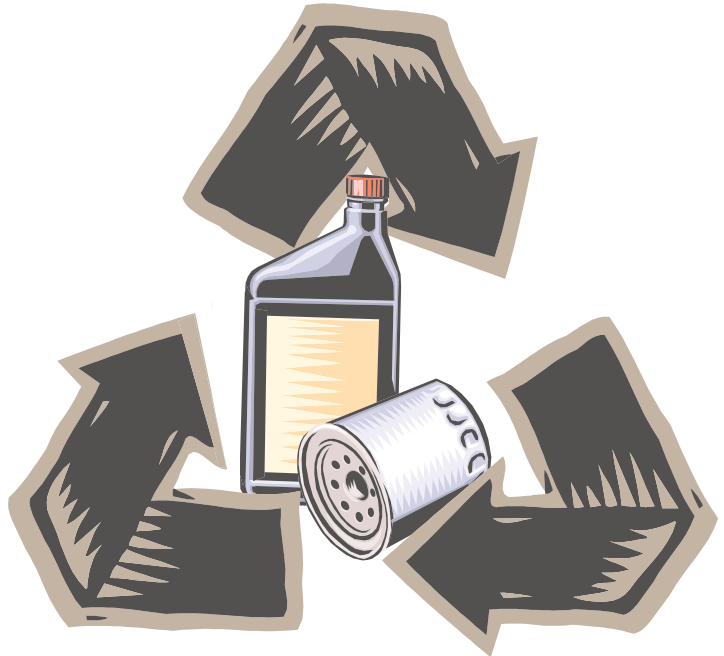


Waste Oil/Filter Recycling in River Bend

The Town of River Bend, in order to assist residents with the disposal of used oil filters in light of the recent legislation banning them from the landfill, is providing, at no cost, a service to accept these filters. Users of this service, by prior arrangement, will be able to bring their used oil filters to a convenient site and dispose of them in a barrel provided by a contractor secured by the Town.

This contractor will also be pumping waste oil from a storage container owned by the Town. So, also by prior arrangement, residents may bring waste motor oil to our site for disposal at no cost.

It is important that those wanting to use this service make arrangements with the Public Works department before coming to the site. This will ensure our staff is able to be at the site to accept and account for the material.



Here are some guidelines for the use of this service:

1. Available for all residents of River Bend for oil/filters generated through personal use.
2. Only uncontaminated oil will be accepted (not mixed with water, anti-freeze, etc.), and the user of this service must retain their transport container. No gasoline, gas/oil mixtures, or solvents will be accepted.
3. Oil filters must be uncontaminated and the user of this service must retain their transport container.
4. This service will be available, by arrangement, during the regular work day: Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. — 4:00 p.m.
5. Users must call the Director of Public Works at 638-3870 ext. 206 to arrange for the recycling site to be attended.
6. Improper handling and/or disposal of waste oil/filters remains the responsibility of the user of this service until the products are accepted by Public Works staff.
7. The staff member present has the right to reject all or part of a user's material.
